


## What can you do?

Often age-related illnesses cause a gradual change in your pet, which can be very difficult to spot. To make sure your pet receives the correct care when they need it, it is important that pet owners keep records of eating and sleeping habits and behavioural changes. Keeping a diary, as well as handling your pet regularly to check for lumps and bumps, will help you to spot any concerns as soon as possible.

For most breeds of dog, senior years begin at 7-8, where as cats reach middle age around 10. Just like with humans your pets dietary needs will change as they get older, this is the time to reassess what you are feeding your pet. 

## How we can help

Old age is not a disease, many problems that are common in older pets can often be treated, supported or avoided all together! Early detection of age-related illnesses does not always mean medication for life, often treatment could start with a simple change in diet, or a visit to weight watchers!

Early screening for age related issues will mean your pet receives the correct treatment as soon as possible, Blood pressure and urine tests also help to assess your pets overall health and identify any areas that may cause your pet problems, now or in the future.
